 Description
 - Our Bylaws Currently State in Section (Article IV, Section 8, Subsection I, d):
 - a) "Create and oversee an Equity, Inclusion, Diversity, and Access Committee that will be composed of at least one member from each chapter."
 - Proposed change: to remove the portion stating "composed of at least one member from each chapter"
 - a) Reasoning: This prevents the issue of the EIDA Director having to run a committee in which half the members were forced to be there/who are not interested in the topic
 - Proposed addition: to add a requirement that this position will hold at least one roundtable per semester with the chapter DEI chairs
 - a) Reasoning: Able to get feedback from the committee at roundtables
