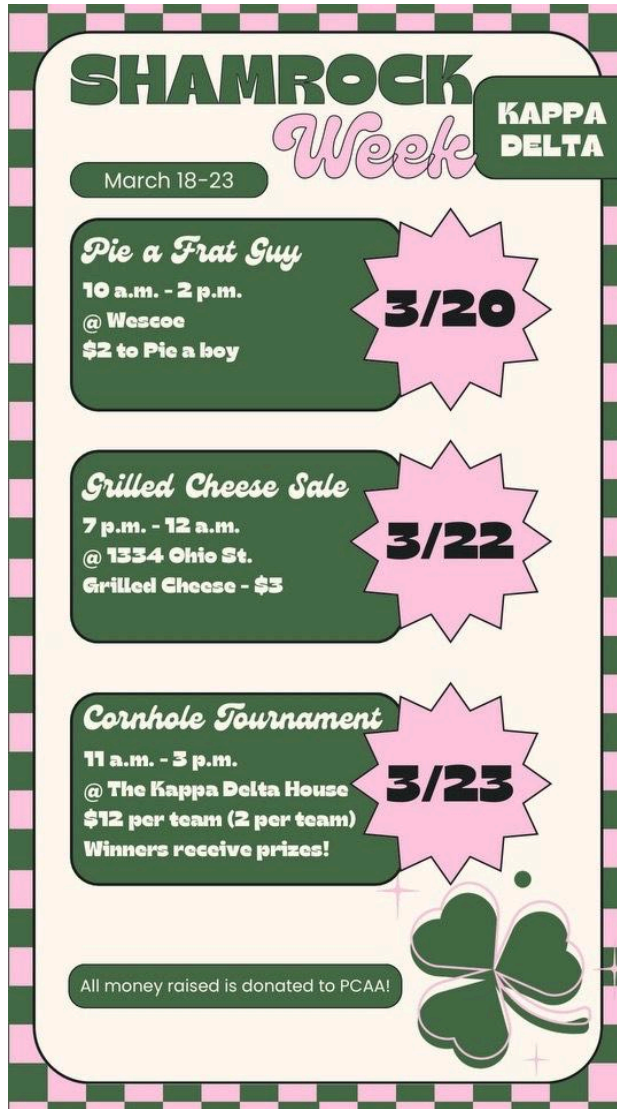
- **Alpha Chi Omega, Maddie Milligan** - axophi.panhellenicdelegate@gmail.com
