- Proposal of New Bylaws
 - o Article III: Membership Class, Section 1, A
 - Original: Regular membership. The regular membership of the University of Kansas Panhellenic Association shall be composed of all chapters of NPC fraternities at the University of Kansas Regular members of the College Panhellenic Council shall pay dues as determined by the College Panhellenic Council. Each regular member shall have voice and one vote on all matters.
 - Proposed: Regular membership. The regular membership of the University of Kansas Panhellenic Association shall be composed of all chapters of NPC fraternities at the University of Kansas Regular members of the College Panhellenic Council shall pay dues as determined by the College Panhellenic Council. Each regular member shall have voice and one vote on all matters. Dues are set at \$35 per member for each Panhellenic Association Member Fraternity. The cost of dues is up for review every three years in conjunction with executive board stipends.
 - Reason: This was discussed with chapter presidents at a president round table. The total of \$35 was agreed upon by chapter presidents. This bylaw revision will hopefully eliminate the discrepancies between what Panhellenic is charging members and what the chapters actually charge.
 - o Article III, Section 1, H Social Media Behavior, c
 - Original: Prohibited social media behavior includes but is not limited to: persuasive posts and/or tagline on photos (i.e. "Go Alpha Beta" or "Rush Alpha Beta), taglines or phrases used to suggest a promise of a bid, and phrases used by chapters at bid day activities. Members will be encouraged to utilize their chapter's approved recruitment tagline.
 - **Proposed**:Prohibited social media behavior includes but is not limited to: persuasive posts and/or tagline on photos (Rush Alpha Beta), taglines, or phrases used to suggest a promise of a bid, and phrases used by chapters at bid day activities. Members will be encouraged to utilize their chapter's approved recruitment tagline or "Go Alpha Beta".
 - Reason: Chapters will still not be allowed to say "Rush Alpha Beta" as that is not proper terminology. Chapters expressed that they would like to be able to say "Go Alpha Beta" as that is not showing preference to one specific chapter and it equalizes the playing field for all chapters.
