VIII. Old Business

- o AGD Return Agreement
 - As outlined in the Individual Chapter Membership Growth Plan (1999, 2018, 2020) BEST PRACTICE: The NPC member organization (in this case, Alpha Gamma Delta) and the College Panhellenic Council must have an annual discussion about the status of the re-establishment agreement. The discussion should result in a mutual agreement to renew (continue under existing terms and timeline), edit (alter the terms and timeline), terminate (end the agreement) or implement (start the process of the NPC member organization's return to campus according to the re-establishment proposal and timeline) the re-establishment agreement. The College Panhellenic Council will determine whether the annual discussion will take place in person or by electronic means.
 - a) Since we cannot renew or implement as the timeline has passed, and if you all do not agree with the edit of a Fall 2023 timeline that AGD proposed, we will need to find another mutually agreeable decision with Alpha Gamma Delta.
