Resolution Examples	<p>Prescribed sanction assessed by chapter or peer judicial board.</p> <p>Chapter self-governs and sanctions the individuals or chapter as appropriate.</p> <p>If necessary, chapter or headquarters leadership may refer incidents to the governing council or Student Conduct and Community Standards for additional action.</p>	<p>Partnership process: chapter self-reports and self-investigates, then shares findings with governing council judicial board. Chapter may self-sanction. Council judicial board renders decision and sanctions, if any.</p> <p>OR...</p> <p>Governing council judicial board investigates and adjudicates. Council sanctions the chapter as appropriate.</p>	<p>Partnership process: chapter self-reports and self-investigates, then shares findings with governing council judicial board.
